

BITESAX EXCHANGE PRIVACY POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for visiting Bitesax Exchange (<https://bitesax.com>) a digital asset trading website.

By visiting, accessing, or using Bitesax Exchange (<https://bitesax.com>) and associated application program interface or mobile applications (“Site”), you consent to the policies and practices of our privacy policy (the “Privacy Policy”), so please read them carefully.

This Privacy Policy explains how Bitesax Exchange uses your Personal Data (defined below) as we provide you with access and utility through our digital asset trading platform via software, API (application program interface), technologies, products and/or functionalities (“Service”). In the course of providing you our Service, to abide by the laws in the jurisdictions that we operate, and to improve our services, we need to collect and maintain personal information about you. As a rule, we never disclose any personal information about our customers to any non-affiliated third parties, except as described below.

This Privacy Policy regulates the issues connected with the collection, storage, distribution and protection of confidentiality of the User data, and also sets the obligations and requirements for the User and the website.

This Privacy Policy applies only to the Bitesax (<https://bitesax.com>) website and all services offered by Bitesax. Bitesax does not control and is not liable for the websites located on domains other than Bitesax Exchange (<https://bitesax.com>) (hereinafter the “Website”).

It is recommended to review this Privacy Policy periodically to find out about its amendments. If you continue to use the Services after the amendments come into effect, you thereby accept the Privacy Policy as amended.

Bitesax Exchange may update, edit and amend this Confidentiality Policy, and after then it is immediately published on the Website.

Amendments to the Confidentiality Policy enter into force immediately after its publication unless otherwise is stated in the amendments. By continuing to use the Services, you respectively accept the Confidentiality Policy with all the amendments made.

2. DEFINITIONS

Virtual Financial Asset

As used herein, “Virtual Financial Asset” is also called “convertible virtual currency,” “cryptocurrency,” or “digital goods”, such as bitcoin or ether, which is based on the cryptographic protocol of a computer network that may be

- (i) centralized or decentralized,
- (ii) closed or open-source, and
- (iii) used as a medium of exchange and/or store of value.

Personal Data

As used herein, “Personal Data” means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person, such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, economic, cultural or social identity of you as a natural person.

3. WHAT PERSONAL DATA WE COLLECT

3.1. Bitesax Exchange collects, processes, and stores Personal Data collected from you via your use of the Service or where you have given your consent. This Personal Data may include contact details, copies of identification documentation provided by you or derived from publicly accessible databases, your government identification number as well as information relating to your device or internet service (such as an IP address and a MAC number).

3.2. We collect information you provide during the Bitesax Exchange onboarding process, which may be a completed, incomplete, or abandoned process.

3.3. We may also collect and store certain information automatically when you visit the Site. Examples include the internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer or device to the internet, connection information such as browser type and version, your operating system and platform, a unique reference number linked to the data you enter on our system, login details, the full URL clickstream to, through and from the Site (including date and time), cookie number and your activity on our Site, including the pages you visited, the searches you made and, if relevant, the products/services you purchased.

3.4. We may receive information about you from third parties if you use any websites or social media platforms operated by third parties (for example, Facebook, Instagram, Twitter etc.) and, if such functionality is available, you have chosen to link your profile on the Site with your profile on those other websites or social media platforms.

3.5. We take our responsibilities under Data Protection Act (the “DPA”) seriously. We also recognize the importance of the personal data you have entrusted to us and believe that it is our responsibility to properly manage, protect and process your personal data. To understand more about how we protect the data collected from individuals and entities, please see the details below.

3.6. We collect, use, store, and transfer your Personal Data, which may include the following:

Individual customers:

- Email address
- Mobile phone number
- Full legal name (including former name, and names in local language)
- Nationality
- Passport number, or any government issued ID number
- Date of birth (“DOB”)
- Proof of identity (e.g. passport, driver’s license, or government-issued ID)
- Residential address
- Proof of residency
- Additional Personal Data or documentation at the discretion of our Compliance Team

Corporate customers:

- Corporate legal name (including the legal name in local language)
- Incorporation/registration Information
- Full legal name of all beneficial owners, directors, and legal representatives
- Address (principal place of business and/or other physical locations)
- Proof of legal existence
- Description of the business
- Percentage of ownership for Individual/corporate owners
- Contact information of owners, principals, and executive management (as applicable)
- Proof of identity (e.g., passport, driver’s license, or government-issued ID) for significant individual beneficial owner of the institutional customer entity

- Personal Data for each entity's significant beneficial owner of the institutional customer entity (see the "Individual Customer" section above for details on what Personal Data we collect for individuals)
- Source of wealth
- Amount of bitcoin or other digital assets projected to be injected

3.7. We are entitled to verify the authenticity of the provided User data, his/her identity card or any other documentation on third-party databases. You should realize and give consent that your information/documentation will be used in the following cases.

4. COOKIES

4.1. We may use cookies, web beacons and other similar technologies to collect information about the interaction of the User with the Site and to identify you from other users on the Site.

4.2. A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer or device. They help to save information about the actions of the User and the use of the website.

4.3. You can block or deactivate cookies in your browser settings.

4.4. We use log-in cookies in order to remember you when you have logged in for a seamless experience.

4.5. We use session cookies to track your movements from page to page and in order to store your selected inputs so you are not constantly asked for the same information.

4.6. This Site uses Google Analytics which is one of the most widespread and trusted analytics solution on the web for helping us to understand how you use the Site and ways that we can improve your experience. These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the Site and the pages that you visit so we can continue to produce engaging content.

4.7. By continuing to use the Site, you are agreeing to the use of cookies on the Site as outlined above. However, please note that we have no control over the cookies used by third parties.

5. INFORMATION SECURITY

5.1. Bitesax Exchange makes every effort to protect the confidentiality of personal User data.

We take various measures to ensure information security, including encryption of the Bitesax communications with SSL; required two-factor authentication for all sessions; periodic review of our Personal Data collection, storage, and processing practices; and restricted access to your Personal Data on a need-to-know bases for our employees and vendors who are subject to strict contractual confidentiality obligations.

Despite the efforts we make to secure and store personal information collected from the Website, we cannot guarantee 100% security of personal data during transmission or storage in our systems.

5.2. Interaction with Bitesax is carried out by the User on his own initiative; personal data, allowed for processing under this Confidentiality Policy, are provided by the User at his/her own risk.

5.3. User personal data are stored in a safe and confidential mode for a period no longer than necessary in accordance with the aim of their processing and used strictly for its intended purpose specified in this Confidentiality Policy.

5.4. Links to external sites. the website may contain links to external websites. If you click on the link of the external website, you will be redirected to this website. The company is not liable for the content and activities of such websites, as well as for ensuring your privacy, therefore it is strongly recommended that you review the confidentiality policies of each visited website.

6. MARKETING

6.1. We use the data provided by the User to deliver additional marketing information about the products and services we offer, as well as to improve the services we provide or to solve emerging issues.
